

## Superintendent's Report August 19, 2019

<u>Trophies and Banners</u> - Rushford-Peterson, like all schools, struggle with how best to handle a growing inventory of trophies that accumulate over many years. R-P is a bit unique in that we have had a couple of unoccupied buildings to store these trophies in over the last few years. That time has ended.

In researching what other schools have done I do believe I have a solid recommendation for the Board.

- 1) Banners have been retired and new banners hang in our new gymnasium.
- 2) Trophies that were deemed significant have already been relocated to the new high school.
- 3) Community historical societies will take some of the older trophies that are directly connected to individual schools / communities from the past.
- 4) All remaining trophies in our former buildings simply do not have a display location or long-term storage location available.

## Recommendation - Plan

- 1) Trophies will be removed and inventorized.
- 2) First place, or other significant trophies, that remain will be <u>digitized and available to all</u> on the district's website.
- Inventory of remaining trophies could then be placed on-line and sold to the highest bidder by a determined date. All proceeds would go to support ongoing R-P school activities.
- 4) Committee will work to establish a long-term policy on the length various trophies will be on display and how they will be rotated out. We would then repeat the auction process.
