**Subject:** Fire and Security Systems & Monitoring Services and Other Related Products and Services – Cooperative Contract(s)

### Background Information:

- This recommendation is to provide multiple procurement options for fire and security systems and monitoring services needed for district operations to provide a safe environment for the students and staff of LISD, utilizing LISD-eligible cooperative contracts.
- Products and services purchased under this recommendation are used for routine needs, including but not limited to fire and security systems, backflow testing and repairs, and monitoring services.
- If approved, allowing the use of LISD-eligible cooperative contracts for this commodity, the District will have access to a wide range of vendors, products, services, and pricing to help provide the best value.
- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include but are not limited to price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors.
- Interlocal cooperative contracts have gone through a competitive procurement process and comply with local and state procurement laws.

### Administrative Consideration:

- Funds for these products and services will come from the Facility Services Department operating funds and other previously approved budgets.
- Previous annual expenditures for this commodity:
  - 2024–2025: \$398,415
- Estimated annual expenditures for this commodity: \$438,500 but will not exceed the approved budgets.

### Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the use of LISD-eligible cooperative contract(s) for Fire and Security Systems & Monitoring Services and Other Related Products and Services, the associated awarded vendors, and the estimated annual expenditures for one year.
