BOARD GOAL: Keller Independent School District facilities and services will

FISCAL NOTE: 2006 Bond Funds

Background Information:

- It is necessary to select architectural firms to prepare contract documents for Elementary School #20 and Elementary School #21 for the 2006 Bond issue.
- At the same time, it is necessary to select a method of delivery for these projects.

Administrative Considerations:

- These projects will include the design and construction of two elementary school campuses for completion fall of 2008.
- Site constraints dictate the use of a two-story design.
- Due to the scope of the projects and the delivery schedule, district building prototypes are recommended. The district standard of Construction Manager at Risk is also recommended.

The administration recommends, based on project parameters and past performance, that the Board of Trustees approve contracting with VLK Architects for Elementary #20 and Hahnfeld, Hoffer, Stanford Architects for Elementary #21 and approve using the Construction Manager at Risk method of delivery for both projects.
