~~A basic diploma is designed for students with specific learning needs. Students seeking this diploma will need to meet identical credit requirements as outlined in Morrow County School District Policy IKF-Standard.~~

~~For the class of 2009 and beyond, a Basic Diploma will be awarded when fifty percent(50%) or more of the courses in the four core areas of English, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics were awarded by specialists with adaptations to content materials, assessment, and grading.~~

~~For the class of 2007, a Basic Diploma will be awarded when eighty percent(80%) or more of the courses in the four core areas of English, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics were awarded by specialists with adaptations to content materials, assessment, and grading.~~

~~For the class of 2008, a Basic Diploma will be awarded when seventy percent(70%) or more of the courses in the four core areas of English, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics were awarded by specialists with adaptations to content materials, assessment, and grading.~~

~~In accordance with Oregon State Law, special education students earning a Basic Diploma are eligible for special education transition services to age 21. This will be effective for the graduating class of 2009~~

~~Additional requirements as per Policy IKF-Standard (i.e. Educational Plan & Profile, Extended Application, Career-Related Learning and Learning Experiences) are also required.~~
