WHO IS HOMELESS?

- A. Means individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence, and includes:
- B. Children and youths who are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters, are abandoned in hospitals; or are awaiting foster care;
- C. Children and youths who have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings
- D. Children and youths who are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings; and
- E. Migratory children who qualify as homeless for the purposes of this title and satisfy conditions A thru D.
