#### 1. ENROLLMENT COUNT AS OF 2/28/2011:

# 3. SITE COUNCIL – 2<sup>ND</sup> TRIMESTER MEETINGS

Members of the council met November 30<sup>th</sup>, January 31<sup>st</sup>, & February 28<sup>th</sup>. Due to Winter Break, there was no meeting for December planned. Meeting items for discussion included technology upgrades for LBMS, budget shortfalls for this year & next, ideas to help ease the hardship of the budget cuts, and the structuring and management of the Site Council. They meet the last working day of each month. The committee is made up of at least two licensed staff, two classified staff, two parent or community members, and one building Administrator. #### 4. EVENTS: "Seussical the Musical" Drama/Musical performance – November 7 – 11, 2010

This performance was a combination of the LBMS Drama Club & Music department. They did a wonderful job and attracted an audience that spanned all ages. The students truly learned so much, and put so much of themselves into this activity. Mr. Brice Cloyd, the director for both of these departments, did a great job producing this program and working with the students. This was a program offered through our 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning Grant for After-School Activities.

#### 5. EVENTS: Dell Arte Presents – December 3, 2010

Each year around the holidays, the Dell Arte performers, from Blue Lake, CA, come to the Illinois Valley to provide a drama performance for the community, usually with a holiday theme. Their entry fee is free to the community, but they do ask for a canned good donation-which is then donated to food banks in the Illinois Valley. This year, they performed "The Musicians of Brenan". The attendance was very good, and the donations really helped the local food banks.

#### 6. EVENTS: WINTER CONCERTS – December 2010

The Winter Concert, held during the week of December 13th, was very entertaining. All sections of the music department performed during a series of days the week of December 13<sup>th</sup>. Community support has been overwhelming this year. The music department is working hard to raise the funds needed for their trip to Anaheim, CA to participate in the annual Heritage Music Festival. It was a great turn out, and the students did a great job with presentation. They will be attending a "SMILE MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH CHALLENGE" at *Western Oregon University* March 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>. While on this trip, they will also tour parts of *Oregon State University*. This is an awesome experience for these students, as well as an exceptional learning opportunity.

#### 9. LEARNING THROUGH ARTS – Week of February 21st, 2011
