Background:

For three years, Antioch had an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Fox Lake and Big Hollow for the position of Hearing Impaired. This is typically a very difficult position to fill. We have been very fortunate to have Emily Taylor in that role. She has navigated ten buildings across three districts.

Analysis:

Historically, Fox Lake has held the Intergovernmental Agreement. Emily was contracted for 10% of her time in Fox Lake, 20% in Big Hollow and 70% in D34. This model has saved the District a great deal of money. Without this IGA, D34 would have to contract with an agency, paying a premium.

Due to the fact that D34 contracts the greatest amount of her time, we are recommending that Antioch be the “holder” of the IGA. Other than what district’s actually pays Emily, very little will change. Below is the breakout of the costs.

\$4,276.02	*Fox Lake
\$9,175.80	Big Hollow
\$32,115.30	Antioch D34
\$45,567.12	Total Salary

*Fox Lake currently pays for Emily’s cell phone. This cost is \$311.88 per year. They are willing to continue to pay that cost which will reduce their payment accordingly.

Recommendation/Motion:

Administration seeks approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Hearing Itinerant Teacher with Fox Lake and Big Hollow in the amount of \$32,115.30, as proposed.
