Summary:

On April 18, 2022, Board of Trustees approved the award of RFQ 2122-003-RQ for Architect and Engineer Services, included in the award is Teague Nall Perkins, Inc. (TNP) for civil engineering services.

Terrell ISD is using TNP for Playground Refresh Topography, Survey, Design, and Construction Administration, Terrell HS Track Resurface Design and Construction Administration, and we are planning to use TNP services for Sub Utility Engineering at Terrell HS Additions and Renovations, CTE Additions and Renovations, and Ag Center.

The aggregate value of these services will exceed the \$100,000.00 threshold and requires Board of Trustees approval.
