



Subject: Adopt Sale of Equipment Resolution

Date: April 15, 2025

Last year, the Board of Education declared 4 school buses as surplus equipment. These buses were deemed to be at the end of their useful life and were no longer in the rotation used by First Student. Recently, First Student approached the district with an offer of \$2,000 to purchase all 4 of these buses to be used for replacement parts on our current, operable fleet.

These factors, along with the fact that it would likely cost the district more money to remove or dispose of the buses, lead us to investigate this offer. In discussions with legal counsel, we were provided with the attached Resolution authorizing the sale of these buses to First Student. The Resolution includes an acknowledgement of the Board declaring these as surplus, a list of the property being sold, and a purchase/sale agreement to be signed by district and First Student representatives. Below is a list of buses being sold:

1. #281 - 2007 Thomas Saf-t-liner - 4UZABRCT67CW18825
2. #282 - 2007 Thomas Saf-t-liner - 4UZABRCT87CW18826
3. #283 - 2007 Thomas Saf-t-liner - 4UZABRCTX7CW18827
4. #284 - 2007 Thomas Saf-t-liner - 4UZABRCT17CW18828

Once the Resolution is passed, district administrators will finalize the sale of the buses with First Student and provide them with all the necessary, signed documents per the Illinois Secretary of State.
