


Who are Adult Lifelong Learning Participants?

Over 50% of participants in Adult Lifelong Learning have a Forest Lake mailing address.


The "Other" category includes residents of over 30 communities including northern suburbs of both Minneapolis and St. Paul as well as communities in western Wisconsin.






Registrations show that approximately 68% of Adult Lifelong Learning participants are female. While women outnumber men in most classes, a few classes including Co-ed Volleyball, Competitive Table Tennis and Men's Basketball are predominantly made up of male participants.

The on-line registration program does not require participants to include their date of birth. Many adults choose to not include it, therefore this chart is based on approximately 40% of adult participants from Fall 2013 through Summer 2014.
