

The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 64% to 92% by August of 2024

Two-Sided Approach

Campus Wide Support

- 1. Staff will have the opportunity to attend training in high yield teaching strategies that promote College and Career Readiness.
- 2. Campus administration receives training to enhance the campus environment systemically, so every student is on track toward college or/a career.

Elective

- Elective class recruits students who have the cognitive ability and desire to participate in Advanced Placement classes.
- 2. Students in the elective become part of a team that is focused on providing not only academic support, but also guidance and encouragement along the way.

Eye on the Prize

- 76% of AVID Seniors are from low socioeconomic status backgrounds
- 86% are underrepresented students
- 94% Complete four-year college entrance requirements
- 90% who apply are accepted into four-year colleges
- 84% who enroll in college persist into the second year

Today AVID is present at Navo Middle, Rodriguez Middle, and Braswell High School in grades seven through ten

Next year we will expand the number of students in the elective classes. We are identifying incoming sixth-graders who will participate in the elective. We are also expanding to the Freshman Academy at Guyer High School.
