Unity School District - Board of Education Board Policy 434.2 Closed Campus Last Revised 8/14/2018

The Unity School District is a closed campus. Students will not be permitted to leave the school grounds during the school day without written approval of the principal or designee.

Students who are on accepted release programs, at the high school, or those students who have appointments as outlined in the attendance policy may leave school according to their identified release time by checking out of the office.

At the high school, student work or apprenticeship programs may result in students not attending a full day of school. Seniors may also earn a privilege of an open lunch and resource time. Students must be in good standing as defined by the Student Handbook. Parent/guardian permission is required. The high school principal reserves the right to close campus for an individual student at any time.

Students violating the policy will be subject to disciplinary action as defined by the Student Handbook.
