## **Educational Objectives:**

- 1. To show students the diverse world of biology and ecology
- 2. To introduce students to many varieties of plants and animals not traditionally seen in Oak Park, and to show how their populations are interdependent
- 3. To improve students' geographical awareness
- 4. To deepen students' environmental awareness as stewards of the land
- 5. To deepen students' understanding of Illinois history
- 6. To encourage and improve students' physical fitness

## Cost:

The cost of this educational field trip is \$115.00. However, the Hatch PTO will offset the cost with a very generous donation of \$29.00 per child. The PTO will also pay for the bus trips to and from White Pines and the \$57.50 per parent/guardian that volunteers their time to participate in the program.
