The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition, there were over 295 work orders submitted during the month of April 2025.

Here are just a few of the projects that have recently been completed:



The maintenance team has been busy removing old fence structures to make room for new security fencing. This section at the south end of the baseball facility will soon be replaced with a black iron fence and power gates.





In April, the crew tackled a major project at Phillips Elementary. A series of drains were installed to help clear water from the parking lot.



The crew mixed and poured over 15,000 pounds of concrete during the scope of work. There have been multiple rain events since the completion of the project and the drain system has worked nicely.





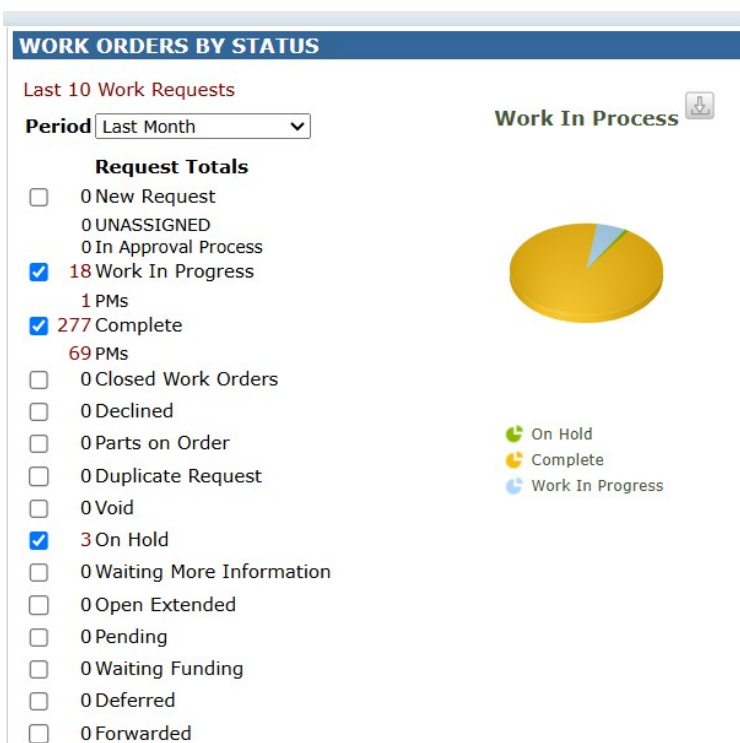
The athletic department brought in a storage container to help secure supplies and equipment at the baseball field (pictured above). Maintenance used some heavy equipment to help move that container into the proper place



This little shed may not look like much, but it was constructed to protect a major irrigation pump in the district. The shed is outfitted with a heating system that will keep it from freezing up during the winter months.
