REPORT: RECEIVE STANDARDIZED DRESS CODE UPDATE

The information herein are based on the current dress code from local Board policies and recommended changes for the 2013-14 school year by district discipline committee.

2013-14 Student Dress Code Recommended Changes

- 1. Add gray shirts
- 2. Add spirit shirts
- 3. Add college shirts
- 4. No slides (ie: athletic, sandals etc.)
- 5. No leggings, tights, or jeggings worn as outerwear
- 6. The district does not have a symbol or district logo to date. A sew or iron on patch is planned to be adhered to clothing as part of the standard uniform options.
- 7. "Power Mondays"- Professional dress/Leadership focus
- 8. Allow any color/pattern jackets, belts or shoes
