Part-Time Online Students: 359

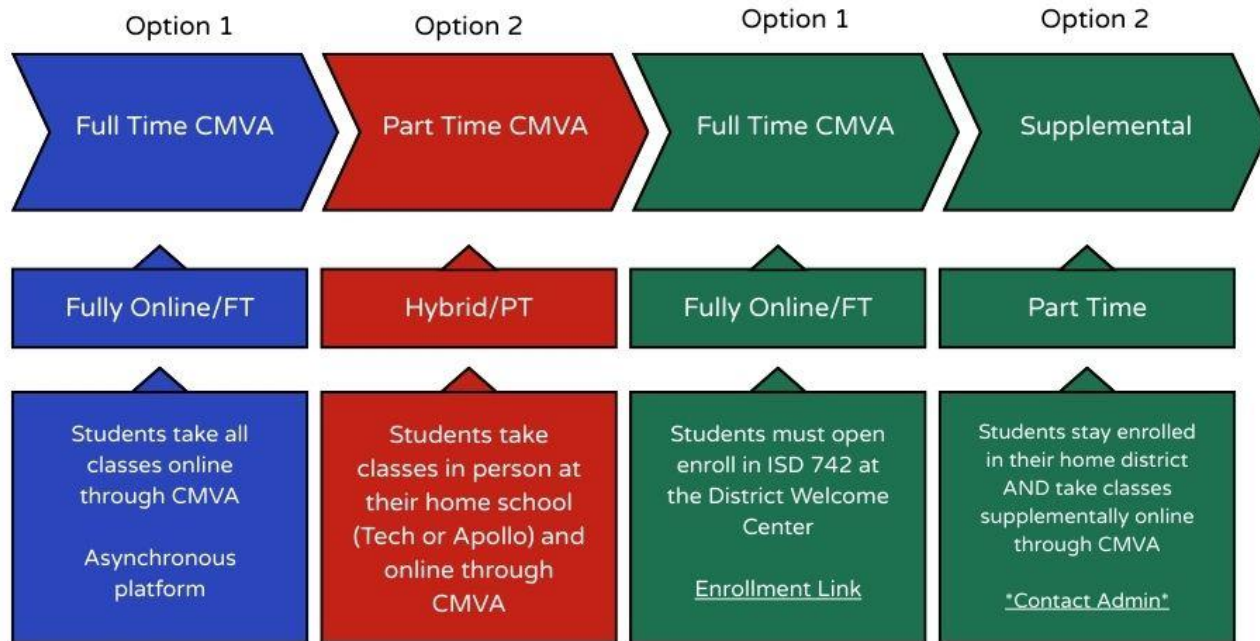

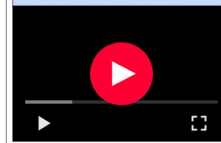

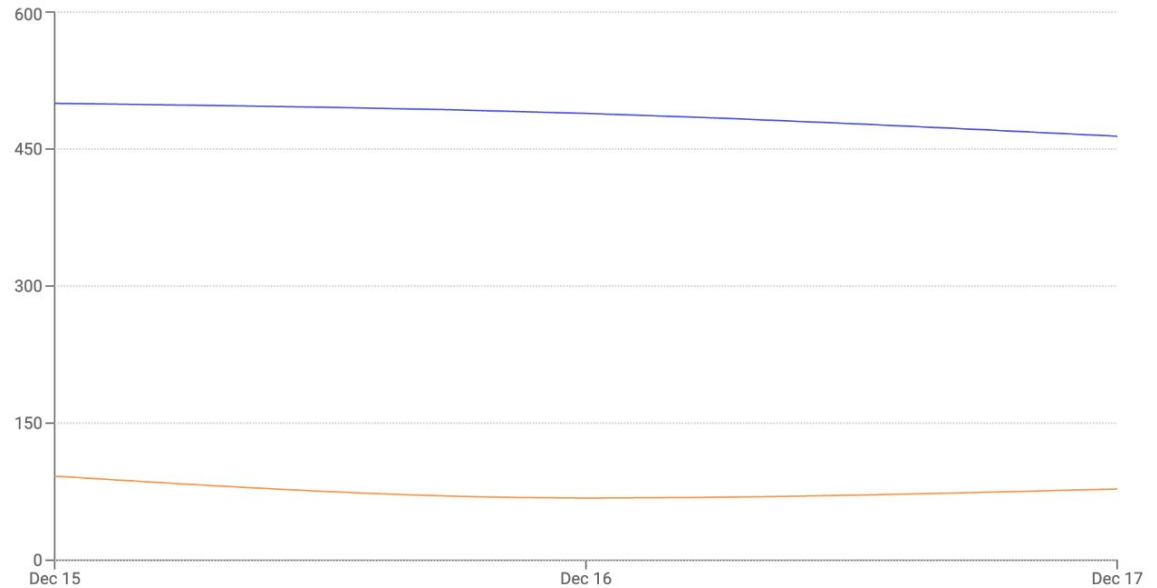
