### Background Information:

- Brazosport ISD has had a long-standing partnership with Brazosport College for dual credit classes.
- High school students are able to take a number of dual credit courses at Brazosport College, at the high school, or online.
- Students have the opportunity to earn an Associate's Degree if they choose to.
- Through the Catalyst Program beginning in a student's junior year, they can earn an Associate's Degree in Process Technology or Instrumentation, or continue their education after graduating from high school and earn a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Management at no cost.

### Administrative Considerations:

- Students who meet the criteria for Economically Disadvantaged do not pay tuition or for books.
- BISD pays for the tuition and fees for students who are not Economically Disadvantaged up to 2 courses per semester.
- Our newest partnership to consider is creating an Early College model. In the Early College, students beginning their freshman year would commit to a pathway that would earn them an Associate's Degree during their four years of high school.
