# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Humanities eTextbook Adoption

This report highlights the process involved in selecting 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Humanities text materials that are aligned to the Illinois Learning Standards, C3 (NCSS College, Career, Civic Readiness), and the Common Core State Standards. Included are the members of the selection committee, the process followed for the selection of materials, specific recommendations for materials, and the purchase costs.

## **Timeline of the Curriculum Study**

The process for selecting a 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Humanities text started almost three years ago (the last text purchase was 2003). With changes due to the inclusion of the Common Core State Standards and more recently the C3 standards, the process to purchase became slower and more deliberate to ensure that the standards were embedded throughout the text and supported by supplementary materials.
