Indus Transportation Contract Discussion. Notes: Reinke Bus Company will no longer be serving the Indus' transportation needs beginning school year 2023-24. Indus transportation bids are open until March 31, 2023. No bids have been received at this time. Maggert Transportation offered to help provide buses but drivers would still be needed. There are two district buses available. Scott Mai suggested advertising for bus drivers. Superintendent Jeremy Tammi offered to post job positions for bus drivers via newspaper and Facebook. Indus has 3 bus routes along with 1 van route and would be in need of four drivers, possibly three, considering Indus Para Steve Kramer currently drives bus for Reinke Bus Company.

FY23 Budget Discussion. Notes: FY23 revised budget was presented by Superintendent Jeremy Tammi which included ESSER revenue, a decrease in anticipated timber sales and a final roofing cost. Northome and Indus schools indoor air quality projects, a new Northome elevator, a Northome gymnasium scoreboard and the Indus wastewater treatment facility needing to be decommissioned were also discussed.

Mrs. Holte took our band students to Backus Band Days in International Falls. (2/15) The students got the opportunity to perform with other local schools and learn what it is like to play in a large ensemble. The freezer compressor on our large lunch room freezer quit working on the 13th. We had to scramble to save our food. The part will be replaced on Wednesday the 15th. Students have been cross country skiing and ice skating! It has been so nice out we are enjoying the weather while it lasts!

Northome Principal's Report: Last week we had Homecoming. Our theme this year was VS. Winner Takes All. Student Council hosted a week full of fun and challenging activities. I want to thank everyone that helped out throughout the week as well as those that supervised the dance. Fun was had by all. We had our All School Celebration last week as well. Students were recognized for having Positive Attitudes and showing Kindness. Last week was School Counselor Appreciation Week. I would like to thank Christine Lundin for everything she does to support our students so each of them can be successful. Next Wednesday is Bus Driver Appreciation Day! We will be showing our appreciation to our amazing bus drivers with cards and treats. I want to thank each of them for getting our students to and from school safely each day. This week is Kindness Week, each day students and staff have the opportunity to fill out a heart to recognize someone showing kindness. Names are drawn each day and recognized on the announcements. Every day is a good day to be kind. February is I Love to Read Month. Our elementary students have been celebrating all month so far with mystery readers, flashlight reading and lots of reading challenges. They are working to read enough books so their book chain reaches my office. If they are successful with this, they will have a big surprise coming their way. Superintendent's Report: A compressor went out on the Indus Freezer over this past weekend. A part has been ordered with an estimated cost of part replacement and labor around \$3,500 and the plan was to have the compressor repaired today. In the meantime, a chest freezer was purchased from Menards to store the frozen goods. Northome school and the City of Northome had an unplanned power outage on Monday, February 13th. The power went out around 10:30AM. We were in communication with North Itasca throughout the morning and they could not give a time frame when the power would be restored. I made the decision around 12:00 to have an early dismissal since there were no lights in the building and water pressure was an issue. Northome students were dismissed at 1:00PM. The Northome School had a roof leak with the warmer temperatures. I contacted Nelson's Roofing and they send a crew up to take a look on Monday. They reported that they found

some T-Seams around a drain that needed additional caulking. Our school district has registered for three Virtual Career Fairs: Minnesota Educators Career Fair on March 23rd and April 13th, UMD/UofW Superior Virtual Career Fair on April 6th.
