DESCRIPTION:

The Long-Term Facilities Maintenance (LTFM) revenue legislation gives school districts the authority to utilize the revenue program. The LTFM revenue is a product of \$380 per Adjusted Pupil Unit (APU) and is equalized property tax levy. Annually the District is required to develop and approve a LTFM 10-year plan for both projected revenue and expenditures. The attached resolution approves the 10-Year LTFM plan and authorizes a property tax levy payable in 2025 for fiscal 2026. This plan includes the 10-year expenditure plan that was reviewed and approved by the board on April 18, 2024.

The ten-year plan contains the following types of expenditures:

- Health and safety projects and assessments
- Fire testing and monitoring
- Building envelope repair
- Grounds repairs and/or replacements
- HVAC preventative maintenance
- Electrical and Plumbing maintenance
- Flooring and painting
- Other items anticipated to occur over the next ten years

Recommend approval of the attached resolution adopting the 10-year LTFM plan for the fiscal year 2025-26.
