TOPIC: Approval to Purchase Computers for Livonia Career Technical Center

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 26 Hewlett Packard computers and display monitors (including Care Pack services) from CDW for the LCTC Engineering Design class, totaling \$88,584.60.
