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The attached chart represents the results of the April 2014 Grades 5 & 8 1<sup>st</sup> Administration Results for South San Antonio ISD. These tests were administered April 1-4, 2014.



These results are official and were posted by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) on April 21, 2014. Copies of the Confidential Campus Rosters and Summary Reports have been provided to all elementary and middle schools and to the Office of the Superintendent.

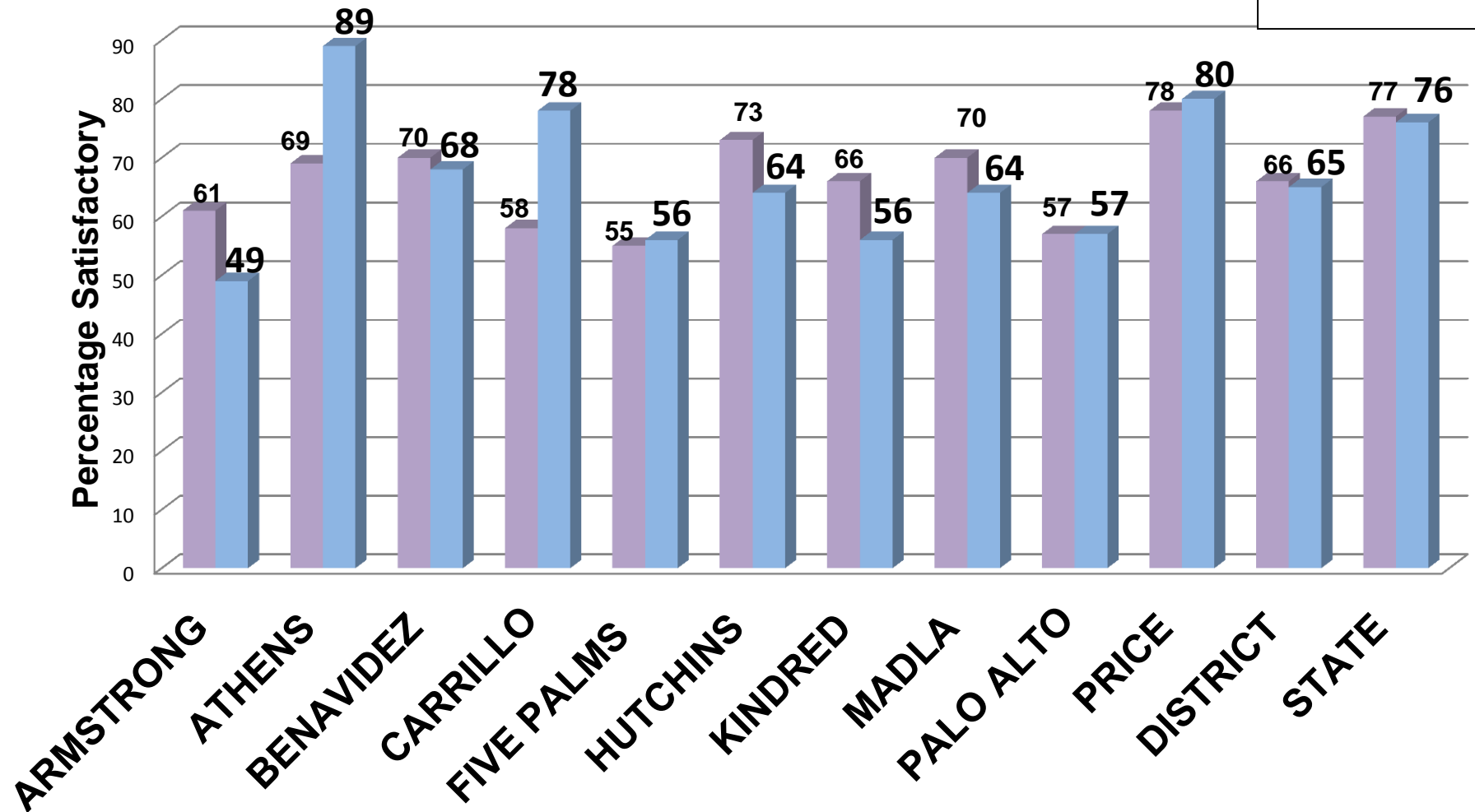
South San Antonio ISD schools have notified parents and students of their results. These tests are a part of the TEA Student Success Initiative that requires that a student demonstrate proficiency on Grades 5 & 8 Reading and Math assessments prior to advancing to the next grade level. If a student did not pass this first administration they are now a part of required accelerated instruction prior to the 2<sup>nd</sup> administration of these tests on May 13-14, 2014. A Grade Placement Committee (GPC) meeting must take place after each administration for those students not demonstrating proficiency. The GPC is required to consider the recommendation of the student's subject teacher, grades, test scores and any other relevant academic information for accelerated instruction and advancement decisions.

It is also important to note that the Grades 5 & 8 final accountability results for Reading and Math will be a combined 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> administration results. If you have any questions, please contact me through the Office of the Superintendent. Thank you.

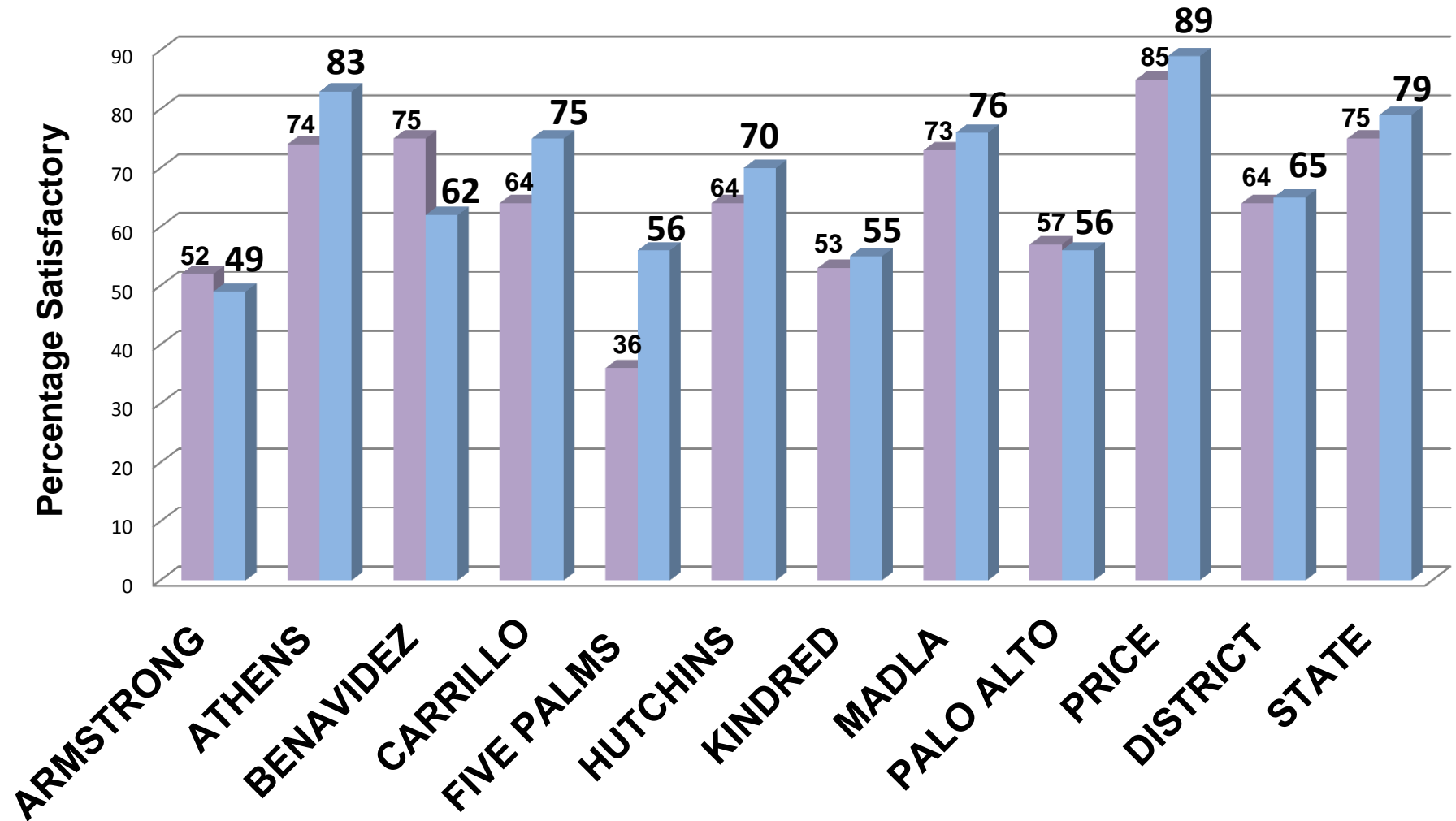

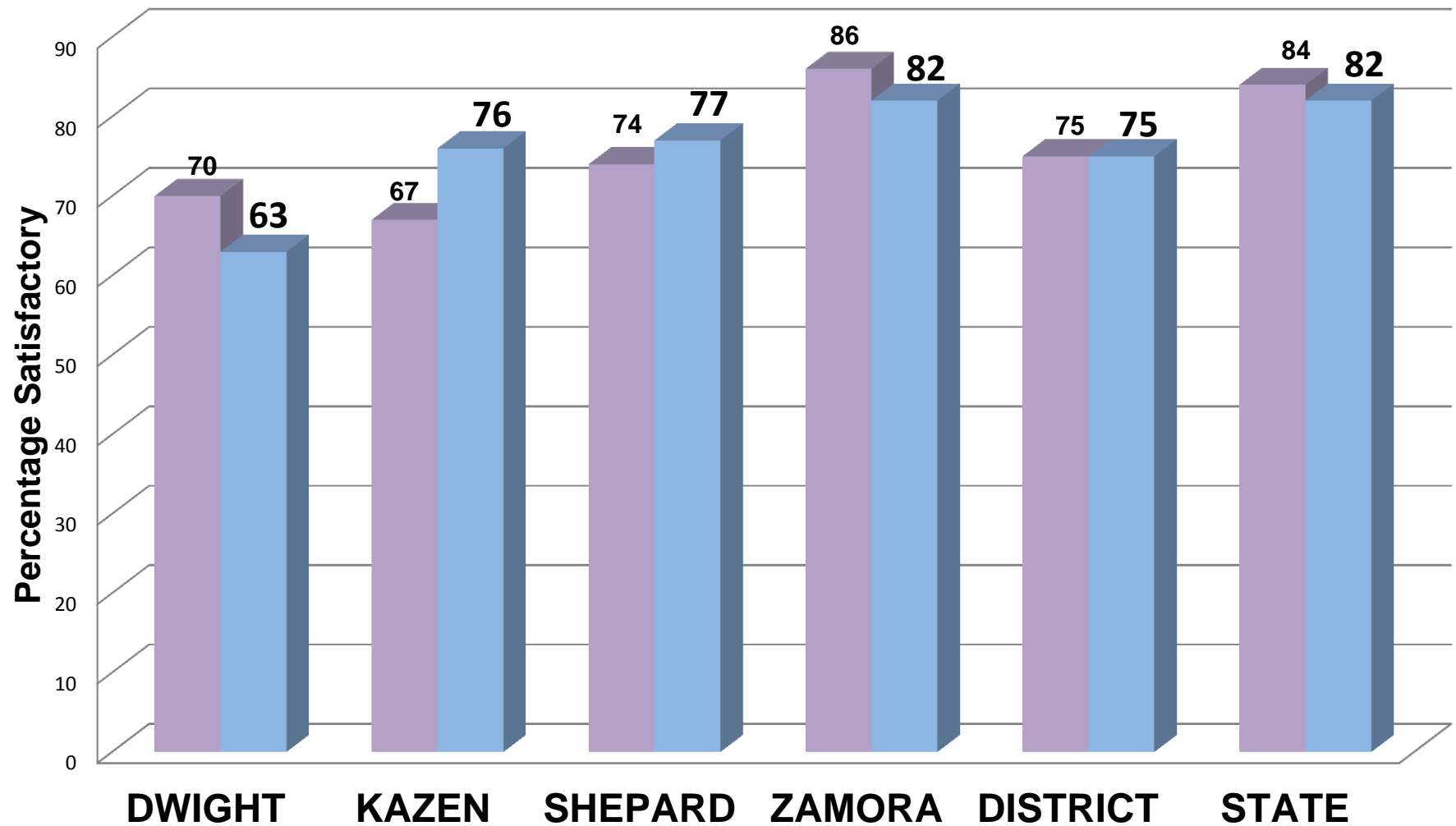
