We are in the self study process with our NAEYC accreditation

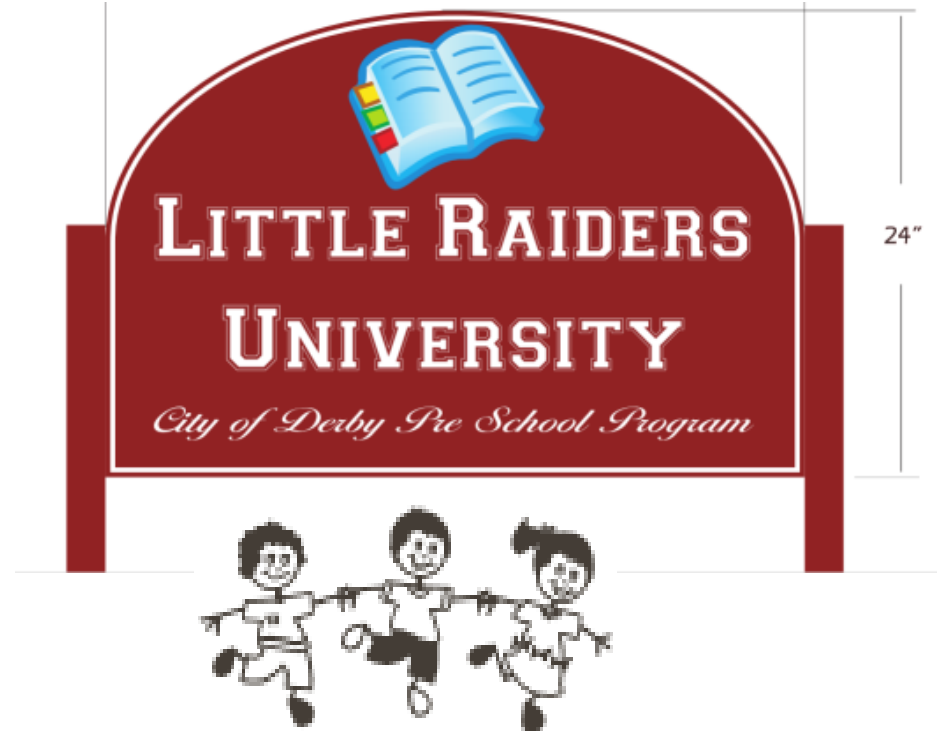
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# Operations
