This packet is generated by an automated process that compares the updated policy to the district's current policy, as found in TASB Policy Service records.

In this packet, you will find:

- Policies being recommended for revision (annotated)
- New policies (not annotated)

Policies recommended for deletion are not included. If you want to include the text of these policies in the information given to the Board, you may download them from *Policy On Line*.

Annotations are shown as follows.

- *Deletions* are shown in a red strike-through font: ~~deleted text~~.
- *Additions* are shown in a blue, bold font: **new text**.
- Blocks of text that have been *moved* without alteration are shown in green, with double underline and double strike-through formatting to distinguish the text's destination from its origin: ~~moved text~~ becomes moved text.
- *Revision bars* appear in the right margin, as above.

NOTE: While the annotation software competently identifies simple changes, large or complicated changes—as in an extensive rewrite—may be more difficult to follow. In addition, Policy Service's recent migration to Word 2013 causes some margin notes to appear as a tracked change where no change has taken place.

Membership	The Board shall consist of seven members.
Method of Election	Election of Board members shall be by position.
Election Date	General election of board members shall be on the May uniform election date.
Terms and Election Schedule of Elections	Board members Trustees shall be elected by position or place for three-year terms, with elections conducted held annually, as follows indicated below :
Positions 1, 2, and 3	The election for positions 1, 2, and 3 current term expires in the year 2004. Subsequent elections shall be held take place in 2019, 2022, 2025 2007 and 2010 , and in at three-year intervals thereafter in a like manner .
Positions 4 and 5	The election for positions 4 and 5 shall be held in 2020, 2023, 2026, and The current term expires in the year 2005. Subsequent elections shall take place in 2008 and 2011, and at three-year intervals thereafter in a like manner .
Positions 6 and 7	The election for positions 6 and 7 current term expires in the year 2003. Subsequent elections shall be held take place in 2018, 2021, 2024 2006 and 2009 , and in at three-year intervals thereafter.
Method of Voting	To be elected, a candidate must receive a majority of the votes cast for the position.
Majority Vote	in a like manner.
