Re: Card Access Control Additions – 2016 Bond Project #13

As part of the 2016 Bond Projects (Project #13), each campus is to receive approximately two additional card access control devices on exterior doors.

The Interlocal Contract purchasing method, as provided in the Texas Education Code 44.031, was used to obtain proposals through the Educational Purchasing Cooperative of North Texas (EPCNT).

McKinney Security (also a sole source provider for our card access system) provided the proposal with the best value for the district at a total turn-key cost of **\$72,681.98**. \$150,000 was estimated for this project.

The pricing is turn-key and includes all materials, labor, and installation for a total of twenty two (22) additional doors.

McKinney Security has worked for Coppell ISD and several other local school districts around the metroplex over the years, and is our sole source provider for our card access control system district-wide.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve McKinney

Security as the contractor to complete the district-wide card

access control additions for the sum of \$72,681.98.
