AGENDA ITEM: WAIVERS

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): Learning

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The TEA allows districts to apply to the Commissioner for a waiver of a requirement or restriction imposed in the Texas Education Code. A waiver may be submitted for a period of three years.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS: Aledo will submit the following waivers:

<u>Staff Development Waiver</u> ~ This waiver allows districts to train staff on various educational strategies designed to improve student performance in lieu of a maximum of three days of student instruction. Aledo has 2 days built into the calendar.

<u>Early Release Waiver</u> ~ This waiver allows the district to conduct school for less than seven hours for a total of six days of student instruction a year. Aledo has 2 early release days each semester for a total of 4.

<u>Foreign Exchange Student</u> ~ This waiver allows the district to limit the number of foreign exchange students to a number that is less than 5 per high school .
