Summary:	Review of the planned use of federal grant funds for the 2026-2027 school year and an opportunity for stakeholder feedback prior to submission of grant applications to the Texas Education Agency (TEA).
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	Federal law requires stakeholder consultation during the development of certain federal grant applications, including the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Special Education (IDEA-B), and Perkins V: Strengthening Career & Technical Education for the 21st Century grants. District staff will present the proposed use of grant funds and gather feedback from stakeholders prior to final submission of grant applications to TEA.
Potential Operational Impact:	Federal grant funds support supplemental staffing, instructional programs, professional development, parent and family engagement activities, services for English learners, and initiatives aligned to district and campus improvement.
Potential Financial Impact	The District anticipates receiving federal grant funding to support approved supplemental programs and services for the 2026–2027 school year.
