Fall = late Sept/Oct, Winter = mid-January/February, Spring = Late April/May; this would usually correspond with when screeners (probes) are completed at the building level.

The level A criteria are those who should be seen first or most often. Level B would be the next level, who based on groups and group size would be seen next if room in title. The sight words are based on end of the year expectations. The K/1 grade cut-offs are 25-33% Fall, 40-50% winter, and 60-70% for Spring of the grade level expectations. The ORF, LNF, LSF, and NWF are based on the 10th and 25th percentile. The cutoff scores listed are just above the 10th percentile for level A and just below the 25th for level B. We want to use more than one data point to show they need Title I. Classroom data can also be used to show a need for Title I if there is conflicting data in the chart or if more data is needed.

ORF is based on the 2005 Hasbrouck & Tindal Norm Table. LNF, LSF, NWF are based on the 2007 AIMSweb Norm table.
