Special Education Activities

- Montana Autism Project Training ~ I participated in the Montana Autism Project Training presented by OPI. Some very interesting facts were shared that are impacting Special Education Programs with an increase of students identified as autistic. Since the 2011-12 Statewide Child Count there has been a growth rate of 12% for school aged children identified as autistic. Statewide numbers for 2011-12 school year was 16,032 students, and for 2018-19 school year, 19,389, that is a 3,357 student increase in 8 years. Our district is also feeling this increase as the need for PCA's and specialized trainings are on the rise at Browning Public Schools.
- MANDT training will be Friday, December 13, 2019. It is a full 8hr training to receive certification, all new PCA's and selected other individuals will be part of the training.
