## RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMBINED POLLING PLACES FOR MULTIPLE PRECINCTS AND DESIGNATING HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLING PLACES WILL REMAIN OPEN FOR VOTING FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION

WHEREAS Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The School Board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.

**WHEREAS** Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 205A.11, the School Board may establish a combined polling place for several precincts for school district elections not held on the day of a statewide election. Each combined polling place must be a polling place that has been designated for use as a polling place by a county or municipality.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the School Board of Independent School District No. 2190, Yellow Medicine East, State of Minnesota, as follows:

The combined polling places designated in this resolution are the polling places unless a change is made in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 205A.11, subdivision 2; or pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 204B.175; or because a polling place has become unavailable.

The following combined polling places are established to serve the precincts specified for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election in the calendar year following the adoption of this resolution:

Kilowatt Community Center 600 Kilowatt Drive Granite Falls, MN 56241

This combined polling place serves all territory in Independent School District No. 2190 located in Chippewa, Lac qui Parle, Redwood, Renville, and Yellow Medicine Counties, Minnesota.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.09 the polling places will remain open for voting for school district elections not held on the same day as a statewide election between the hours of 8 o'clock AM and 8 o'clock PM.

The clerk is directed to file a copy of this resolution with the county auditors of each of the counties in which the school district is located, in whole or in part, within thirty (30) days after its adoption.

As required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 204B.16, subdivision 1a, the clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give written notice if the location of a polling place has changed to each affected household with at least one registered voter in the precinct stating the location of the new polling place. The notice must be a nonforwardable notice mailed at least twenty five (25) days before the date of the first election to which it will apply. A notice that is returned as undeliverable must be forwarded immediately to the appropriate county auditor. This paragraph does not apply to a polling place location that is changed on election day under Minnesota Statutes, section 204B.175.
