

**SUBJECT:** Consideration and possible approval of the Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment and TEKS Certification for the 2026-2027 school year.

**BACKGROUND:** Districts and open enrollment charter schools are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that, for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills and that the Instructional Materials and Technology Allotment (IMTA) is used only for expenses allowed by the Texas Education Code. For the 2026-2027 school year, our district has instructional materials that collectively cover all elements of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills of the required curriculum identified in the TEC §28.002 for each subject and grade level (TEC §31.004)
