TOPIC: Approval of Bid Results for Custodial Cleaning Equipment – 2013 Bond

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of six 26" rider auto scrubbers and ten 26" stand on auto scrubbers from HP Products in Belleville, Michigan for \$159,516.78 and ten 16" cleaning path carpet extractors from KSS Enterprises in Plymouth, Michigan for \$19,890.00; for a total of \$179,406.78.

The purchase of the cleaning equipment will enable the K-12 custodial personnel to more efficiently and expeditiously complete floor cleaning duties. This will increase custodial staff productivity.
