CONFERENCES: We had 86% attendance to our Spring Conferences in March.

BOOK FAIR: The PTO held a book fair during conferences. They made \$5,613 (\$3,702 in book credit) which is the most money they have ever earned. The PTO went with a local book fair company out of Meridian and received 60% back instead of the standard 50% from Scholastic. Teachers made a "wish list" for parents to buy books and for the teachers to receive new books for their classrooms. We certainly appreciate the parents and PTO for their support!

<u>JUMP ROPE FOR HEART:</u> Mr. Long held a week-long Jump Rope for Heart event during his PE classes. Students secured pledges from family and friends. The students raised around \$500 for the American Heart Association.

FIRST GRADE NEXT YEAR: With 81 Kindergarten students plus the 13 Pre-First students, there would be 94 possible First Grade students for the 2017-2018 school year. With a possible 12-13 students going to Pre-First, there would still be 27 students per classroom with only 3 First Grade teachers. That number is unacceptable in a primary classroom. My options are to have Mrs. Harper teach First Grade again and do away with the Pre-First program, or discuss hiring another First Grade teacher.
