

Positive Happenings Forest Lake Area Schools Community Education Youth Athletics








Community Education offers a variety of athletic opportunities for our area youth. Some of our most popular activities include: Baseball, Basketball, Soccer, Touch Football, Volleyball and Wrestling.

- We start in the fall with the Elementary Volleyball league. This league is for girls in grades 3-6 and runs from September through the third week of November. This program usually has around 370 players and approximately 40 teams. We finish with a tournament for the 5th and 6th grade teams.
- Elementary Touch Football (grades K-9) also begins in September. This is a new program in the last three years and is extremely popular.
- In November we have an Introductory Wrestling program which is for ages 4-12. This is another program that is new in the past three years.
- Elementary Basketball starts in December and finishes in February. This program is for boys and girls in grades 3-6. This program usually has between 70 and 80 teams. We end the season with a 5th and 6th grade tournament.
- March signals the start of spring and everyone starting to sign up for baseball. Elementary
 Baseball is our biggest program with around 940 players. Leagues in each grade level (K-6) will
 make approximately 65-80 teams. We have a mid-season tournament.



- We also have North Star Baseball League for 7-9 grade boys in the summer. The Forest Lake teams compete against other north metro teams and may qualify for the MYAS state tournament. A tournament for Forest Lake teams only ends the season in August.
- Club Lacrosse is for boys and girls in 7-12 grade that want to experience a great up and coming sport. This program runs Monday through Thursday for six weeks in April and May.
- Elementary Soccer is offered in July and August. This is for grades K-6 for both boys and girls. This program usually has around 350 players and approximately 37 teams. Games are played at two venues, Columbus and Wyoming elementary schools.
- We also have many camps and clinics for preschool through grade 12 students. Tennis, basketball, baseball, lacrosse, volleyball, soccer and dance line camps are being offered this summer.
