Re: Facilities Update

Daniel Wright Jr High

- The irrigation system for the athletic field at Daniel Wright was started up for the season. Thanks to all the rain, it isn't currently needed, but it will be ready to go when things dry out.
- The track has been painted on the field for the current track and field season. The maintenance department will maintain it through the end of the school year.
- New sand and limestone have been added to the long jump pit and shotput areas at DW in preparation for the track and field season.
- The underground infrastructure work for the EV Bus chargers is continuing on schedule. While the heavy rains have slowed down the process, the work continues. The protective concrete bollards are installed and all trenching has been completed. Underground piping for each of the units is currently being installed.
- Over spring break, we contracted our partners at Midwest Environmental Consulting to perform air testing at Daniel Wright Jr High. We air test all of our buildings on a rotation annually to ensure the indoor air quality is safe for students, staff, and the community that use the facilities day in and day out. We tested 6 different areas around the facility to ensure we obtained a good cross section of all areas. The results came back extremely positive showing little to no contamination of any kind in the indoor air spaces. The full detailed report is posted on our website under the Facilities tab.

- We have received the roof replacement proposal from our team at Tremco and are currently reviewing it in detail. After all of the exact measurements and scans were

taken, the proposal has come back slightly under the suggested budget. We look forward to starting this project in mid June.

- The winter and early spring weather has been especially hard on the wood fence along the property at Half Day. We have secured a contractor to make the necessary repairs when the weather permits over the next couple of weeks.

- The annual pressure test of the elevator at Sprague is scheduled for May 5th. This is a state required safety inspection to ensure the proper operation of elevators.
