Immunizations

For each child enrolled in a class or in sibling care we must have a completed Registration form and an Immunization status form on file. Minnesota Statutes 1980, sec. 123. 70, requires that all children enrolled in a Minnesota Education program be immunized against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, Hib and Hepatitis, pneumonia and varicella. A notarized statement signed by a child's parent or guardian can be submitted to the program indicating that the person has not been immunized as prescribed in state statute 121A.15 because of the conscientiously held beliefs of the parent or guardian.
