6 **Policy Name:** *Suicide Awareness and Prevention*

7 **Regulation:** -----

9 The Administration shall develop and implement a youth suicide prevention program meeting minimum
10 requirements set forth in 10.55.719, ARM. 12.

11
12 The District will provide professional development on youth suicide awareness and prevention to ~~each employee~~
13 **all staff** of the district who work directly with any students enrolled in the school district. The training materials
14 will be approved by the Office of Public Instruction (OPI). The District will provide at least two (2) hours of
15 youth suicide and prevention training beginning the 2017-2018 school year. The District will provide, at a
16 minimum, two (2) hours of youth suicide awareness and prevention training every five (5) years thereafter. All
17 new employees who work directly with any student enrolled in the school district will be provided training the
18 first year of employment.

20 Youth suicide and prevention training may include:
21

- 22 a. In-person attendance at a live training;
23 b. Videoconference;
24 c. An individual program of study of designated materials;
25 d. Self-review modules available online; and
26 e. Any other method chosen by the local school board that is consistent with professional
27 f. development standards.

29 No cause of action may be brought for any loss or damage caused by any act or admission resulting from the
30 implementation of the provisions of this policy or resulting from any training, or lack of training, related to this
31 policy. Nothing in this policy shall be construed to impose a specific duty of care.
