Olympics (Thematic Unit)

Students are engaged in learning about the Olympics. We had an opening ceremony where we learned about the Olympics, did an elementary version of lighting the torch, and met an Olympian. We talked with Philip Dunn who taught us about Race Walking and all the unique experiences that he had as an Olympian in 3 different Olympics.

During our Olympics, we are having a Read-lympics to see what classes log the most independent reading minutes over the span of the Olympics. The students are challenged to read 300 minutes /5 hours during the challenge . We even had some students finish the challenge during the first weekend.

We are also doing a "Be an Olympian" challenge in which there are secret judges writing down students and whole classes names if they are showing good character with moments of teamwork, kindness, dedication, helpfulness and respectfulness. If students get written down for these qualities then their class earns a medal. We will see which class gets noticed showing the characteristics of being an Olympian the most.

Ice Skating

Students have been Ice Skating as a part of the PE curriculum the past two weeks. Thanks in huge part to generous community donations, we are able to outfit all of our K-5 students with their own skates that they get to keep in their locker during the unit. Students really enjoy getting better at skating and learning about the different events involved with skating including speed skating.

In an effort to continue to grow our students with independent reading, students and families got to participate in a book fair Feb 7-11. Many of our families responded with excitement to this opportunity and joined their student in selecting books to purchase. We sold over \$3712 in physical books.
