



For the month of September our 2nd and 3rd grade students started new curriculums for literacy. Teachers started with routines and procedures that support the implementation of Benchmark reading that sets them up to begin Unit 1 in October. All students assessed on Aimsweb for math and reading. All 2nd grade students were assessed for placement within WIN (What I Need) intervention. Third grade will continue instruction where they left off last spring but go back 10 lessons. All 2nd and 3rd grade WIN groups are now walking to intervention groups. We distributed all curriculum and held professional development for WIN, Benchmark, Math, and UFLI.





We would like to welcome Mrs. Aimsback to BES as our Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Specialist. Counselors have been working on providing a Social Skills curriculum to students at Browning Elementary. Topics include learning about healthy boundaries, learning about respect and showing kindness toward others. These classes are part of the special rotation for all 2nd and 3rd grade students. Counselors continue to work on building those positive relations with the students each day. We are also scheduling for
