Accelerator Application

United ISD has submitted an instructional plan that will allow students to apply for the possibility of enrolling in a Hybrid Plan of Instruction providing 3 days of on-campus learning and 2 days of synchronous learning.

We are pending TEA's approval.

The 2021 State Legislative Session is scheduled to end on May 28, 2021. The session is reviewing House and Senate Bills that would allow school districts to establish policies for admission in virtual learning and count virtual learning time toward funding for average daily attendance.

UISD is currently surveying parents and students to gather information on virtual learning for future instructional planning.

An update on 21-22 instructional plans will be presented as soon as all legislative bills are finalized and signed by the Governor.
