

Instructional consultants from Side-by-Side Educational Consulting, Transformative Teaching Group, Strive, and Custom Educational Consulting continue to meet monthly with schools across the district to support MTSS implementation, new program adoptions in ELA and mathematics, as well as support literacy initiatives at the building level. Browning Public Schools is in year three of the Montana Comprehensive Literacy State Development Program (MCLSDP) a grant funded program to support family literacy, social-emotional development, as well as high-quality reading instruction and intervention development over five years.

### **On-going Instructional Coach's Team Training to Support Teachers**

Instructional Coach's across the district are participating in a winter series of trainings that include; creating high-impact professional development, instructional coaching to build collective teacher efficacy, the art of coaching teacher emotions, as well as building and coaching instructional teams.



## **ASSESSMENT**

### Winter Benchmarking and Writing Assessment

The Aimsweb Winter Benchmarking window is January 10th-28th for all students in K-10th grade for ELA and mathematics. Benchmarking assessments provide teachers with critical information about the projected expectation of a student meeting grade-level standards, as well as the ability to determine fall to winter growth for literacy and math skills. The winter writing assessment will be held the week of January 31st and teachers will complete the winter DESSA (SEL screener) for all BPS students the first week of February.
