# **REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:**

To keep the Board apprised of shifting student demographics, emerging insights from student surveys, and the rollout of the Data Den business intelligence platform to strengthen data-informed decision making.

#### **EXPECTED OUTCOME/RELEVANCE TO STRATEGIC PRIORITY OR CORE THEME:**

Strengthens the Board's ability to make evidence-based policy and budget choices by illuminating current student needs and trends.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Institutional Research and Reporting (IRR) continuously tracks student demographics and enrollment to surface emerging trends that affect programs, services, and resources. IRR collaborates college-wide to identify information needs and administer timely, well-designed surveys that capture student feedback when it's most actionable. Multi-year development of the Data Den provides employees with access to self-service dashboards and a single source of truth, increasing transparency and encouraging data curiosity across the College. Combined, these IRR-led practices strengthen the Board's ability to make timely, evidence-based decisions and to monitor progress over time.
