# RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DATES FOR FILING AFFIDAVITS OF CANDIDACY

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622, State of Minnesota, as follows:

- 1. The period for filing Affidavits of Candidacy for the office of school board member of Independent School District No. 622 shall begin on July 30, 2024, and shall close on August 13, 2024. An Affidavit of Candidacy must be filed in the office of the School District Clerk and the \$2 filing fee paid prior to 5:00 o'clock p.m. on August 13, 2024.
- 2. The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said filing dates to be published in the official newspaper of the School District at least two (2) weeks prior to the first day to file Affidavits of Candidacy. Publication of said notice prior to the date of adoption of this resolution is hereby ratified and approved in all respects.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of said filing dates to be posted at the administrative offices of the School District at least ten (10) days prior to the first day to file Affidavits of Candidacy.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the period for filing Affidavits of Candidacy for the office of School Board member of Independent School District No. 622 shall begin on July 30, 2024, and shall close at 5:00 o'clock p.m. on August 13, 2024.

The general election shall be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. At that election, four (4) members will be elected to the School Board for terms of four (4) years each.

Affidavits of Candidacy are available from the School District Clerk, Independent School District No. 622, 2520 East 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, North St. Paul, MN 55109. The filing fee for this office is \$2. A candidate for this office must be an eligible voter, must be 21 years of age or more on assuming office, must have been a resident of the School District from which the candidate seeks election for thirty (30) days before the general election, and must have no other affidavit on file for any other office at the same primary or general election.

While the candidate is not required to provide the address of residence, failure to provide the address of residence will result in an incomplete affidavit of candidacy and the rejection of the affidavit of candidacy, which will result in the omission of the candidate's name from any ballot in the election for which the candidate attempts to file the affidavit of candidacy and pay the filing fee. This information will be available to the filing officer to whom the written request is delivered, to employees of that filing officer and to other elections officials with whom that filing officer consults in order to obtain information necessary to make the determination whether the address of residence listed by the candidate is actually located in the area represented by the office sought.
