Re: February, 2016 Report

- 1. Title I and State Compensatory Education** – We have 312 students who qualified for this program. This number drives our funding for Title 1 and SCE.
- 2. Leading Learning** – I attended this Trainer of Training workshop with Mrs. Keisling and Ms. Jones on February 9th.
- 3. Migrant Webinar** – On February 11, I participated in a webinar for Migrant Students.
- 4. SHARS** – On February 18th, I participated in the required SHARS training webinar.
- 5. Region 16 Instructional Support Collaborative** – I attended this collaborative meeting at the ESC.
- 6. Migrant Visit** – I met with Genna Stotts from the region center on February 24 to review our migrant program.
- 7. TELPAS Calibration** – TEA changed the teacher /rater calibration process this year. I have to monitor the teachers as they go through the calibration. Currently, we have 4 teachers at the HS who successfully calibrated; 2 teachers at the MS and 8 teachers at the ES. I will have at least one more calibration session next week for the remainder of the teacher/raters to calibrate for this year's TELPAS season.
- 8. Social Skills** – two days a week, Mr. Thompson and I are working with a special needs student to improve their social skills.
- 9. §504 meetings** – I attended four 504 meetings for elementary and HS students.
- 10. 4th grade writing**– Mr. Ham invited me to assist with his afterschool tutorial/remediation groups for 4th grade writing. I am working with both groups one day a week.
