Withdrawal From School / Drop-Outs

It is the responsibility of the school administration to identify potential student drop-outs

and to use those resources available to encourage such students to remain in school.

Failing this, the school administration should attempt to guide former students into an

alternative plan of education.

A concerted effort should be made by school administrators and counselors to keep in

contact with students who withdraw from school during the months immediately

following their withdrawal and to encourage those students to reevaluate their decisions

to drop out.
