The project employs a data-driven, tiered approach to instruction that builds on community partnerships to create personalized, expanded learning opportunities for students. The core philosophy is one of enriched activities and wrap around supports focused on success for each student. Individualized, personalized learning plans and a tiered system of interventions, based on academic achievement as well as social-emotional, behavioral and cultural needs, will be used to track and adjust student activities.
