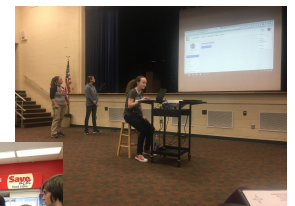
Congrats to Coach Missy Ade and the 7th grade volleyball team on a great season. They were regional champs and fell short of Staunton in the sectional championship.
