## Consideration and take possible action to approve an order of election for a voter approval tax ratification election (VATRE). September 30, 2024

- 1. <u>Board Goal:</u> Domain 4, Objective 1 Alignment of Financial Well Being with Student Achievement
- 2. <u>Background</u>: The District adopted a tax rate during the August 19, 2024 board meeting. By adopting the M & O tax rate of \$0.78690 the district is required to conduct a VATRE.
- 3. <u>Process:</u> The District conducted several budget workshops to discuss the projected revenues and the possibility of adopting a tax rate that would trigger a VATRE throughout the spring and summer.
- 4. Fiscal Impact: \$1,900,000 is the additional revenue included in the 2024-2025 budget
- 5. <u>Recommendation:</u> The Administration recommends the Board approve an order of election for the VATRE

#### 6. Action Required:

Motion: I move to approve an order of election for a voter approval tax ratification election to be held on November 5, 2024, and to be administered by the Uvalde CISD; I further move to delegate authority to the Administration to take all steps necessary to administer the election, including designation of an election judge and polling place workers.

### UVALDE CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ORDER OF VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE ELECTION

A special election is hereby ordered to be held on November 5, 2024, pursuant to Texas Tax Code Sections 26.05 and 26.08 to approve the ad valorem tax rate for Uvalde CISD because the adopted rate exceeds the UCISD Voter-Approval Tax Rate ("VATR").

At the Election, the ballot proposition shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District using the language required by statute:

"Ratifying the ad valorem tax rate of \$.78690 in Uvalde CISD for the current year, a rate that will result in an increase of 11 percent in maintenance and operations tax revenue for the district for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$1,900,000."

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted beginning on October 21 and ending on November 1, 2024.
