ECISD Bilingual Programs

Dual Language-One way

The One-Way Dual Language program serves identified Emergent Bilingual students in Spanish and English to learn content and language simultaneously.

Dual Language-Two way


A two-way dual language program that serves identified Emergent Bilinguals and Monolingual students so that both groups become bilingual and biliterate in the two languages.

Transitional Bilingual Late Exit Model

Transitional /Late-Exit Bilingual is a bilingual program that serves students identified as Emergent Bilinguals to gradually transfer students from Spanish to English-only instruction.

ESL Program

The ESL Program provides intensive instruction in English using second language acquisition strategies to teach academic English to students who speak other languages.







Pre-K through 1st Grade Emergent Bilingual Students in a Dual Language One Way program receive literacy Instruction in their Native Language.


2nd Grade through 5th Grade Emergent Bilinguals receive literacy Instruction in both English and Spanish.








PreK through 4th grade for the year 2022-2023.









Graduating Class of 2021 -2022

- 26% of the top ten students in ECISD high schools were former bilingual/ESL students.
- Thirteen students, including two Valedictorians and one Salutatorian, were served through our Bilingual/ESL program.
- This number is 6% higher than last year.
- Emergent Bilingual Graduation Rate increased from 63.5 % to 70.8%.
- Drop Out Rate for Secondary Emergent Bilinguals reduced from 3.6% to 3.3%
