RECOMMENDATION:

To approve January 26-30, 2026 as Holocaust Remembrance Week.

IMPACT/RATIONALE:

January 26-30, 2026, is Texas Holocaust Remembrance Week. As part of SB 1828, the purpose of the Texas Holocaust Remembrance Week is to bring awareness of the Holocaust, genocides, and antisemitism to Texas students, educators, and the general public by ensuring availability of resources and advising on relevant matters. SB 1828 states that grades K-12 students in Texas must receive Holocaust instruction during the selected week. Judson ISD Curriculum and Instruction department has identified and created avenues within the Curriculum Unit Guides for resources appropriate for each grade level, using the resources and guidelines for best practices provided by THGAAC (Texas Holocaust, Genocide, Antisemitism Advisory Committee). Campuses can choose to house this instruction during a homeroom/advisory period or through Social Studies or Reading/Language Arts instructional time. A folder of resources is available in the Social Studies curriculum folder on the Intranet.
